Vestas receives order for 70 MW in Spain

The Vestas Group has received an order from the Spanish wind farm developer, Generaciones Especiales I, S.L. (GENESA). GENESA belongs to Neo Energía, which is HC Energía and Edp's new company for development of renewable energy for the Neo Energía Group. The order is for a total of 39 units of the V90-1.8 MW wind turbine for two wind power projects in Spain, Munera I and Munera II.

The order includes supply and commissioning of the turbines as well as a VestasOnline remote monitoring system and a service agreement. Delivery of the turbines will begin in the autumn of 2006, and commissioning of the wind power plants is planned to take place from the beginning of 2007.

The projects will be located in Albacete in the region of Castilla La Mancha which is the second largest region in Spain in terms of MW installed.

"We are pleased with this new order from Neo Energía. They have installed more than 90 MW with Vestas technology and this is the fourth wind power plant we supply to them," says Ebbe Funk, President of Vestas Mediterranean West and continues: "This is the third wind power plant we install in the Castilla La Mancha province and we foresee that the region will continue its strong growth in wind over the coming years."

The above order does not affect the Vestas Group's expectations for 2006, cf. Stock exchange announcement No. 40/2005 of 24 November 2005.
