### Vestas receives orders for a total of 82 MW in Poland

Vestas has received two orders for a total of 33 wind turbines for two projects in Poland. The order for the Dobrzyn project consist of 17 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine, and the order for the Wronki project consists of 16 units of the V90-3.0 MW turbine. Both contracts include supply, installation, commissioning, a VestasOnline™ Business SCADA solution as well as a five-year service contract.

The orders have been placed by the Vortex Energy Group, which is a leading German developer. The owner of the projects will be ScanEnergy A/S – a Danish investor within wind power plants,

*“We are very satisfied with these new orders from Vortex Energy that reinforce Vestas’ positive development in the Polish wind energy market, and we look forward to continuing strengthening our position in the market,”* says Klaus Steen Mortensen, President of Vestas Northern Europe A/S.

The Dobrzyn project will be located in the province of Kujawsko-Pomorskie in the Lipnowski region, and the Wronki project will be located in the province of Warmińsko-Mazurskie in the region of Goldapski.

Delivery of the wind turbines for both projects is scheduled for the end of 2008/beginning of 2009, and commissioning is expected during the second quarter of 2009.

*“We are very pleased to place these two orders with Vestas in cooperation with our partner ScanEnergy. With this portfolio we are able to strengthen our position in the emerging Polish market and provide a basis for a promising future business relationship with Vestas,”* says Till Jeske, Board Member of Vortex Polska Sp. z o.o.

The Dobrzyn and the Wronki wind power plants will annually save the environment from approx 80,000 and 98,000 tons of CO<sub>2</sub>, respectively. The total production from the wind power plants will provide enough electricity to power approx 50,000 Polish households.
