Vestas receives 80 MW order for Germany

Vestas has received an order for delivery of 40 V90-2.0 MW wind turbines for the eastern part of Germany. The order has been received from the German company Nordwind Handels GmbH & Co. KG, and the contract includes delivery, installation and commissioning of the turbines, a VestasOnline® Business SCADA solution as well as a ten-year service agreement.

Installation of the turbines will start during the fourth quarter of 2010 and the project is expected to be completed by the beginning of 2011.

"Vestas has been the perfect partner for us for several years, and we look forward to further strengthening our business relations," states Carsten Paatsch, Managing Director of Nordwind Handels-GmbH & Co. KG.

Nordwind Handels GmbH & Co. KG, based in Beiersdorf-Freudenberg, is one of Vestas' largest customers in Germany. Founded in 2003, Nordwind has so far only installed Vestas turbines.
