Danish PM Anders Fogh Rasmussen to open wind farm in California

On Monday, 12 June 2006, Anders Fogh Rasmussen, the Prime Minister of Denmark, will officially commemorate the first V90-3.0 MW wind turbines in North America just outside San Francisco, where Vestas wind turbines are generating clean electricity for Californian consumers.

The commemoration of the Vestas V90-3.0 MW turbines takes place during the Danish Prime Minister's visit to the United States, which has also included a meeting with George W. Bush, the American President, at Camp David. In California, Anders Fogh Rasmussen will be joined by Ditlev Engel, CEO and President of Vestas, for the visit to the Solano County wind farm.

"A large part of Vestas' history was written in the United States – particularly in California – so it seems very appropriate for the Danish Prime Minister to visit here and mark the opening of yet another project involving Vestas turbines," says Jens Søby, President of Vestas Americas A/S. He continues:

"At the same time, the project highlights the strong position Vestas enjoys in the United States, as well as the positive developments that the market for wind energy is currently undergoing here."

Phase I of the Solano County wind farm comprises eight V90-3.0 MW Vestas turbines and is the first phase of a larger development. The V90-3.0 MW Vestas turbine is a model that has already been installed in a number of countries around the world.

"This is the first project on American soil to involve the V90-3.0 MW turbine – a model that is expected to play an important role in the continued growth of the American market for years to come. As such, this project is an important milestone for Vestas," says Jens Søby.

The official commemoration of the V90-3.0 MW turbines will take place on Monday, 12 June 2006, at 3:30pm local time.

Vestas is the leading supplier of wind power technology in the world and a driving force behind the development of the wind power industry. In 2005, Vestas held a 28 per cent share of the American wind turbine market, the world's largest in 2005.

Solano Wind Project fact file:

The project, which is located between San Francisco and Sacramento, is owned by the Sacramento Municipal Utility District, which installed the first wind turbines in Solano County in 1994. Since then, capacity has been increased and older models have been replaced in step with the technological progress of the wind power industry.
