Vestas receives an order for 18 units of the V82 from Madison Gas and Electric

Vestas Americas has received an order for 18 units of V82-1.65 MW wind turbines from Madison Gas and Electric (MGE) for a 29.7 MW wind project, which will be delivered in the second half of 2007. The turbines will compose a portion of the Top of Iowa expansion project in the State of Iowa, located in Worth County adjacent to the existing Top of Iowa project. The existing project consists of 89 Vestas turbines of 900 kW each which are currently being serviced by Vestas. Iowa is one of the leading wind states in the nation, with over 800 MW of installed capacity.

Vestas will supply and commission the 18 wind turbines, and the order also includes a five-year maintenance and service agreement. Worldwide, Vestas has installed over 1,200 MW of the V82 to date. Vestas has previously supplied MGE with 17 units of V47 wind turbines (each 660 kW) for its wind farm in Kewaunee County, Wisconsin. MGE built and operates this wind farm which provides renewable, Wisconsin-based electricity for 3,300 homes.

"Vestas is pleased to become a supplier for another important utility in the Midwestern United States. We are encouraged by MGE's further commitment to wind power and we look forward to repeating our previous success together," says Jens Søby, President of Vestas Americas A/S.

Madison Gas and Electric, based in Madison, Wisconsin, generates and distributes electricity to nearly 136,000 customers in Dane County and purchases and distributes natural gas to more than 137,000 customers in seven south-central and western Wisconsin counties.

Vestas is the world leader in wind technology and a driving force in the development of the wind power industry, with over 22,000 MW of installed capacity and a presence in over 60 countries.
