Vestas receives order for V90-3.0 MW wind turbines in the US

Vestas has received an order for a total of 63 MW consisting of 21 units of the V90-3.0 MW wind turbine for a project in the south-central region of the United States. The order has been placed by WKN Texas LLC, a former subsidiary of Windkraft Nord USA Inc. (WKN USA). WKN USA, a subsidiary of Windkraft Nord AG, Germany, and long time customer of Vestas recently sold WKN Texas LLC to Enel North America, Inc., a subsidiary of Enel SpA.

Vestas will supply, install and commission the wind turbines as well as provide maintenance and service for a five-year period. Shipment of the first turbines will begin in the second quarter of 2007, with the commissioning date set for fourth quarter of 2007.

"We are very pleased to be awarded this contract for V90 wind turbines from WKN Texas LLC. This order is manifesting the importance of the Vestas 3 MW programme as part of the continued growth of the North American market in the coming years," says Jens Søby, President of Vestas Americas A/S and continues. *"At the same time, I am also very pleased to note that WKN, Enel and Vestas have been able to utilize the companies' global presence and been able to extend the excellent relationship from Europe across the Atlantic."*
