Vestas receives order for 11 wind turbines in Chile

Vestas has received an order for 11 units of the V82-1.65 MW wind turbine for the Canela project in Chile. The project is located in the north of Chile, approx 300 km from the capital Santiago de Chile.

Vestas will supply and commission the wind turbines for the project and provide maintenance and service support for a two-year period. Shipment of the turbines will begin in Q2 2007.

The order has been placed by Endesa ECO, which is a company controlled by Endesa Chile. Endesa Chile belongs to the Endesa Group which is one of the largest electricity companies in Spain. The Endesa Group has a portfolio of more than 1,100 MW installed.

When completed, the Canela project will be the largest wind power plant in Chile and only the second wind power plant installed in the country. The Canela wind power plant will have an annual production of 47 GWh, and the estimated annual reduction of CO₂ emissions to the atmosphere will be 25,750 tons.

"The Canela project is very important for Vestas Mediterranean, and the project represents a step forward for Vestas in our current expansion in the Latin American markets", says Mr Ebbe Funk, President of Vestas Mediterranean A/S.

Chile has good wind potentials. Expectations for the market for the coming years are optimistic and the demand for energy is increasing. The Chilean Government wants to diversify its energy mix and the development of wind energy in the country will contribute positively to this.
