Vestas receives order in Ontario, Canada

Vestas Canada has received an order for 24 units of the V82-1.65 MW turbine for four projects in Ontario near Lake Erie. The order comprises delivery and commissioning of the wind turbines as well as a two-year warranty, operation and maintenance agreement.

The 24 V82-1.65 MW turbines will be installed in four projects, each comprising six turbines and equivalent to 9.9 MW. Delivery of the turbines will begin in the autumn of 2007, and commissioning will start in December 2007 and will continue through January 2008.

The order has been placed by AIM PowerGen, a subsidiary of Renewable Energy Generation, which is listed on the Alternative Investment Market in London. AIM PowerGen has significant development activity in a number of provinces in Canada.

"Vestas Canada is very pleased that AIM PowerGen has chosen the Vestas V82-1.65 MW turbine for the first project in Ontario emerging from the Ontario Standard Offer Program", says Jens Søby, President of Vestas Americas A/S and continues: "The V82-1.65 MW turbine is a perfect turbine for the Ontario Standard Offer Program, and we look forward to exploiting other opportunities with AIM PowerGen under this program."

The province of Ontario anticipates that the Standard Offer Program will initiate up to 1,000 MW of renewable energy generation capacity.
