Vestas receives order for V80-2.0 MW turbines for Chile

Vestas Eólica has received an order for 10 units of the V80-2.0 MW wind turbine for the Hualpen Sur project in Chile. The order comprises supply and installation, a 5-year service contract as well as VestasOnline™ Business SCADA system.

The order has been placed by the developer Energías Renovables del Bio Bio S.A, which is a company fully owned by the Spanish company Eólica Navarra. Vestas has previously worked together with Eólica Navarra in France and Spain and now looks forward to further expanding the relationship into Latin America.

“During the past years, Vestas has developed a good relationship with Eólica Navarra on the Iberian Peninsula and we are very satisfied with the fact that Eólica Navarra has chosen Vestas as supplier for their first project in Latin America.” says Oscar Balestro, Sales Director of Vestas Latin America & Caribbean.

This is the second order which Vestas has obtained in Chile during the past three months. Currently Chile has only one wind park. The Chilean wind market does, however, look very promising primarily due to good wind conditions, but also due to the recent positive development within sustainable energy in Chile.

The project will be installed in the Region VII near the city of Concepción in Chile. Delivery is scheduled to start in May 2007, and the project will be completed during the third quarter of 2007.
