Vestas receives order in New Brunswick, Canada

Vestas Canada has received an order for 25 units of the V90-3.0 MW turbine for the Kent Hills project in New Brunswick, Canada, southwest of Moncton near the Bay of Fundy.

The order has been placed by TransAlta Corporation, a power generation and wholesale marketing company based in Calgary Alberta and listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange. TransAlta is a leader in the Canadian wind industry and currently operates over 200 wind turbines.

The order comprises delivery and commissioning of the wind turbines as well as a 5 year service and maintenance agreement. Delivery of the turbines will begin in the summer of 2008, and commissioning will be complete by the end of 2008.

"TransAlta is a long time customer of Vestas, and we are delighted that TransAlta has chosen the V90-3.0 MW turbine for the Kent Hills project, which will add to their existing fleet of V44, V47 and V80 turbines," says Jens Søby, President of Vestas Americas A/S and continues: "This will be the third V90-3.0 MW project in the Atlantic Canada region, which demonstrates the competitiveness of the V90-3.0 MW turbine in this region."
