### Customer day at Vestas' manufacturing facilities in Tianjin, China

Today on 20 September 2007, Vestas Wind Systems A/S will introduce its manufacturing facilities in China to Chinese and other customers from the Asia Pacific region. Vestas has recently opened a new factory for assembly of nacelles and hubs as well as the new generator factory in Tianjin, China. The factories have been established in connection with Vestas' existing Chinese blade factory in TEDA (Tianjin Economic-Technological Development Area).

*"The recent opening of our new nacelle and generator factories marks an important step for Vestas as this is a further strengthening of our position in the market as well as a demonstration of our long-term commitment to the Chinese market," says Thorbjørn N Rasmussen, and continues: "China is one of world's most promising and fastest growing markets for wind power, and the recent announcement from China's National Reform and Development Commission (NDRC) with the target of 15 per cent of China's energy demand to be met by renewables by 2020 confirms this positive development."*
