Vestas receives order for V90-2.0 MW turbines in Germany

Vestas Central Europe has received an order from e.n.o. energy for delivery of 16 units of the V90-2.0 MW turbine for different projects in several parts of Germany. The contract includes delivery, installation and commissioning of the turbines.

"We are very satisfied with this new order, which confirms the continuous positive trend of wind power development in Germany. At the same time, we are very pleased to reaffirm our working relationship with e.n.o. energy," concludes Hans Jørn Rieks, President of Vestas Central Europe A/S.

E.n.o. energy is a German developer which has been operating in the wind sector since 1995. For e.n.o. energy this contract assures a smooth realisation of their projects and continues the long and faithful relationship with Vestas.

"We are proud that despite the economically difficult German market, we have been able to order the 16 V90-2.0 MW turbines with Vestas. In future, e.n.o. energy is planning to expand nationally and internationally and hereby we intend to continue the good dialogue with Vestas and mainly handle the growth together," states Ralf Breuer, Managing Director, e.n.o. energy.

The wind power plant is estimated to produce 67,000 MWh per year, which will satisfy the energy needs of more than 32,000 German households, and corresponds to an annual emission saving of 36,582 tons of CO₂ compared with average EU electricity.
