Vestas receives order for 18 wind turbines for Portugal

Vestas Portugal has received an order for 18 units of the V52-850 kW wind turbine: 12 units for the Pedras project and 6 units for the do Loiral project, both located in Paúl da Serra in the Madeira Island. The Pedras and Loiral contracts include supply, installation, commissioning, VestasOnline™ Business SCADA system, as well as a 3-year service and maintenance agreement.

The order has been placed by ENEREEM, Energias Renováveis, Lda., a company which is 85 per cent owned by EEM – Empresa de Electricidade da Madeira, S.A. – 7.5 per cent by AREAM – Agência Regional da Energia e Ambiente da Região Autónoma da Madeira, Lda. – and 7.5 per cent by Casa da Luz - Empreendimentos Turísticos, Similares, Unipessoal, Lda. ENEREEM's core business is production of electricity from renewable energy sources, and their activity is limited to the Madeira Islands, currently operating 6 units of the V47-660 kW turbine (41.3 per cent of the total wind capacity installed in the Madeira Islands).

“Vestas Portugal is very pleased with this new order. It confirms the good working relationship with ENEREEM, built on a solid and successful track record of our wind turbines in the Madeira Island. Vestas' first wind turbine installed in the Madeira Islands dates back to 2001,” says José Viskinge, General Manager of Vestas Portugal.

The wind power plants will have an estimated annual production of around 38,700 MWh which will save the environment from approximately 27,000 tons of CO₂, compared with average Madeira Island fuel oil generated electricity¹. Furthermore, they will cover the yearly consumption of around 15,870 Madeira Island households², representing 22 per cent of the total number of households of the island³.

Delivery of the turbines is scheduled to start in December 2008, and the projects will be completed by the first quarter of 2009.
