Vestas receives order for 27 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine for Italy

Vestas Italia has received a large order for 27 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine for the project Grottole, which is located in the region of Basilicata in Southern Italy. The turnkey contract includes delivery, installation, commissioning, VestasOnline™ Business SCADA system as well as a service contract for 5 years.

The order has been placed by FRI-EL Grottole S.r.l., a company belonging to the FRI-EL Group, one of the largest renewable energy companies in Italy and one of Vestas' longstanding customers.

"We are very satisfied with this new order in the Basilicata region, which confirms the positive trend of wind power development in that area. By the end of June 2006, Vestas turbines covered 89 per cent of the installed capacity in Basilicata, with 97 MW of the totally installed 109 MW," says Rainer Karan, General Manager of Vestas Italia. *"At the same time, we look forward to working together with FRI-EL on this new project, which confirms FRI-EL's loyalty towards Vestas. Since 2001, FRI-EL has installed a total of 196 MW in Italy - all with Vestas turbines,"* concludes Rainer Karan.

Delivery is scheduled to begin in November 2007, and the project will be completed during the first half of 2008.

The wind power plant has an estimated annual production of 116,000 MWh, which corresponds to an annual emission saving of 63,000 tons of CO₂. When completed, the wind power plant will be able to satisfy the energy needs of more than 48,300 Italian households.
