Vestas sets the first stone of the blade production facility in Daimiel, Castilla La Mancha

On Wednesday 27 June 2007, Vestas set the first stone of the new blade production facility on the site in Daimiel, in Castilla La Mancha. Equipped with a safety helmet and a shovel, José Díaz del Campo, Mayor of Daimiel in Castilla La Mancha, Ole Borup Jakobsen, President of Vestas Blades A/S, and José Manuel Díaz-Salazar, Industry and Technology Advisor in Castilla La Mancha carried out the official act of placing the first stone of the new Vestas' blade production facility in Daimiel.

Approximately 150 guests from the local Government, inhabitants from the City of Daimiel and journalists from several business and industry media of local and national coverage assisted to the event, which started with a welcome speech given by Luis Monge Guiz, Manager of Business Development in Vestas Mediterranean A/S. After the speeches the celebration concluded with tapas and wine for all participants.

"Since Vestas Wind Systems A/S' press release No. 2/2007 and stock exchange announcement No. 49/2006, Vestas has decided to change the scope of the factory, which means we will expand the buildings up to 30,000 square-metres. As a consequence the factory will be operational from the mid 2008", says Ole Borup Jakobsen, President of Vestas Blades A/S.

When fully operational, the plant will have an annual production capacity of approx 1,200 blades. The factory will be located on a piece of land of 200,000 square-metres and employ around 400 people. The blade production will be for the V90 wind turbines, which are very competitive in the Spanish market.

"We are pleased to celebrate this important event, which is a further step towards the consolidation of our position in Castilla La Mancha and in Spain. Together with the nacelle assembly factories in Galicia and in Castilla León, as well as the control systems production plant, the new blade production facility will further increase Vestas' production capacity in Spain, especially for the V90-2.0 MW turbine," says Ebbe Funk, President of Vestas Mediterranean A/S.

Ole Borup Jakobsen, President of Vestas Blades A/S adds: *“Setting the first stone represents the beginning of a strong cooperation between the City of Daimiel and Vestas and a further step towards strengthening the business relations between Spain and Denmark.”*

Vestas has installed three wind power plants with a total capacity of more than 80 MW in Castilla La Mancha. Furthermore, Vestas is currently installing more than 100 turbines in several wind power plants in the region, which will amount to approximately 300 MW.
