Vestas receives order for 25 wind turbines for France

Vestas France has received an order for 25 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine for the St Seine project, located in Côte d'Or in Bourgogne. The project is divided into five turbine supply contracts, including installation, commissioning and the VestasOnline™ Business SCADA system, as well as a 5-year service agreement.

Delivery is scheduled to start in June 2008, and the project will be completed by the first quarter of 2009.

“We are very satisfied with this new order. When installed, this 50 MW project will be the first one in Bourgogne and the first one installed in France, according to the new law related to ZDE and put into effect in July 2007,”* says Nicolas Wolff, General Manager of Vestas France SAS and he adds: *“We are looking forward to strengthening our position in the French market and we hope to continue developing our fruitful business relationship with EOLE-RES.”*

Based in Avignon in the South of France, EOLE-RES is the fruit of an alliance between the French developer, Eole Technologie and Renewable Energy Systems (RES), one of the world's wind power leaders. With more than 1,500 MW currently under development, and 200 MW already installed on the French territory, among them over 100 MW with Vestas turbines, EOLE-RES is considered one of the leaders in mainland France.

In June 2007, the French market reached 2,000 MW wind energy, with 500 MW installed during the first half of this year**. France has an official objective of 10,000 MW for 2013.

*ZDE (Zone de développement éolien/wind development zone): The 19 June 2006 circular on wind development zones, stating the ZDE came into force in July 2007, specifies the three requirements to be fulfilled before approving building permit requests: “having a sufficient wind potential, the possibility to be connected to the grid and respecting the landscape, historic monuments and protected areas all around.” The following feed-in purchase tariffs are applicable in ZDE only.
