Vestas receives orders for 21 turbines for the United Kingdom

Vestas has received an order for 16 units of the V90-3.0 MW wind turbine for the Aikengall Wind Farm, located in East Lothian in Scotland. The contract consists of supply, installation and commissioning of the wind turbines, a Vestas Online Business™ Scada System, as well as a five-year service agreement.

The order has been placed by the UK based company Community Wind Power Ltd.

"It is with great pleasure that we can announce the signing of the Aikengall Wind Farm as it is the second time Community Wind Power purchases V90-3.0 MW turbines from Vestas," says John Childs, Sales Director of Vestas Northern Europe.

Community Wind Power Ltd. owns and operates the Wardlaw Wood wind power plant in Ayrshire and develops wind power plants together with local communities across the UK.

Furthermore, Vestas will supply five V90-3.0 MW wind turbines for the Garves Wind Farm. The project is owned and developed by Platina Finance Limited and is located in the county of Antrim, Northern Ireland. Platina Finance is a private equity firm focused on renewable energy in numerous areas of Europe.
