Vestas receives order for 17 turbines for Sweden

Vestas has received an order for 17 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine for the projects Säliträdsberget and Hedboberget, located in Dalarna. The contract consists of supply, installation and commissioning of the wind turbines, a Vestas Online Business™ Scada System, a Condition Monitoring System as well as a two-year service agreement.

The order has been placed by Vindkompaniet AB, which is one of Scandinavia's largest developers within wind power plants.
