**Vestas receives order for 100 wind turbines in China**

Vestas has received an order for 100 units of the V52-850 kW wind turbine for the Chuandao project in China.

The project is located on the Chuandao Island in the southern Chinese province of Guangdong. The contract includes supply of turbines, the VestasOnline™ Business SCADA system and a two-year service and maintenance agreement.

The order has been placed by China Guangdong Nuclear Wind Power Co. Ltd. Guangdong Nuclear is rapidly developing into one of the key wind power developers in China.

*“Vestas is one of the largest suppliers of turbines to Guangdong Nuclear and we are proud that they once again have decided to use Vestas turbines – it is a clear sign of the trust and professional working relations that have been building up between our two companies”,* says Lars Andersen, Managing Director of Vestas China.

The first delivery phase of the turbines is scheduled to begin in November 2008. The entire project is planned for completion at the end of 2009.
