**Vestas receives order for 40 MW in China**

Vestas has received an order for 20 units of the V80-2.0 MW wind turbine for the Shicheng project in China.

The project is located near Putian in the Southern coastal province of Fujian. The contract includes supply and commissioning of the turbines, a VestasOnline™ Business SCADA system and a two-year service and maintenance agreement..

The order has been placed by FCG (Putian) Wind Power Co., Ltd. The company is becoming one of the leading wind power developers in the Fujian province and is a new customer to Vestas in the Chinese market.

*"We are very pleased with the good cooperation and positive attitude that has characterised the cooperation between our two companies," says Lars Andersen, Managing Director of Vestas China, and continues: "We are excited to see FCG (Putian) Wind Power's ambitious wind power development plans in Fujian, and we are confident that we have now marked the beginning of a long-lasting and positive partnership."*
