Vestas receives order for 48 MW in China

Vestas has received an order for 24 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine for the Sigeng project in China.

The project is located in Dongfang City on the Southern Chinese Island of Hainan. The contract includes supply and commissioning of the wind turbines, a VestasOnline™ Business SCADA system and a two-year service and maintenance agreement.

The order has been placed by CNOOC (Beijing) Energy Investment Co. Ltd. CNOOC is one of the largest oil and gas exploration and production companies in the world, and the company has recently expanded into wind power development as well.

"We are extremely honoured to have been selected as the supplier for CNOOC's first wind power project in China, and we are confident that this is the beginning of a fruitful and long-lasting partnership between our two companies," says Lars Andersen, Managing Director of Vestas China, and continues: *"We are excited to see how Vestas' vision - Wind, Oil and Gas is matching CNOOC's level of ambition and put into work in China."*

Delivery of the first phase of the project is scheduled to begin at the end of 2008, and the entire project is planned for completion at the end of 2009.
