Vestas receives order for 116 V52-850 kW turbines in China

Vestas has received an order for delivery of 116 V52-850 kW wind turbines for Suniteyou Wind Farm III and IV, Xilinguole City, Inner Mongolia Province, China. The order was received from China Guangdong Nuclear Wind Power Co. Ltd.

The contracts include supply and commissioning of the turbines including towers, the VestasOnline™ Business SCADA solution and a two-year service and maintenance agreement.

China Guangdong Nuclear Wind Power Co. Ltd. is rapidly developing into one of the key wind power developers in China and a key partner of Vestas China.

"We are very pleased about this order; the fact that China Guangdong Nuclear Wind Power has once again selected Vestas turbines is proof of both the quality of our product and the overall business case of our wind energy solutions," says Lars Andersen, Managing Director of Vestas China. *"Over the lifetime of a project, Vestas turbines deliver the greatest reliability and the lowest cost of energy in the industry."*

"This is our seventh order signed with China Guangdong Nuclear Wind Power and it demonstrates the trust and excellent working relationship between our two companies. Vestas is strongly committed to the Chinese market and to working with our Chinese partners to support the overall development of China's wind energy sector," says Lars Andersen.

Delivery and commissioning of the turbines is planned for the third quarter of 2009.

Vestas is the world leader in wind technology, with a history of technological innovation and over 30 years of experience in developing, manufacturing, installing and maintaining the world's best-performing wind turbines. Vestas was a pioneer in the wind industry and started to manufacture wind turbines in 1979. In 1987, the company began to concentrate exclusively on wind energy.

Vestas was the first wind turbine company to enter the Chinese market when it installed the first turbines in Shandong and Hainan provinces in 1986. Vestas has installed wind turbines in thirteen provinces in China, from Guangdong in the South to Heilongjiang, Liaoning, and Inner Mongolia in the North and from Xinjiang in the West to Zhejiang and Fujian in the East.

With 1,071 installed wind turbines by July 2008, totalling 926 MW, Vestas is already the biggest accumulated supplier of wind turbines in China. With the opening of a new factory complex in Inner Mongolia and a new foundry factory in Jiangsu in 2009, Vestas will be operating five factory complexes in three different provinces. In Tianjin, Vestas runs the largest wind power-manufacturing complex in China producing generators, blades, nacelles, hubs and control systems. Vestas currently employs more than 1,200 people in China.
