Vestas receives order for V90-2.0 MW turbines for the Czech Republic

Vestas Central Europe has received an order for delivery of 9 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine for the Czech Republic. The order is so far the largest wind turbine order for the Czech Republic - not only for Vestas, but also for the country in general. The contract includes delivery, installation and commissioning of the wind turbines, and the wind power plant will be installed on the plateau of Horni Lodenice in the eastern part of the Czech Republic.

"We are proud to deliver such an important order to the Czech Republic. This demonstrates the growing importance of the Eastern European countries to Vestas and the wind industry," says Hans Jørn Rieks, President of Vestas Central Europe A/S.

The order has been placed by Austrian Wind Power GmbH, a company owned by the BEWAG Group, which is a diversified Group based in Austria. Through its subsidiary Austrian Wind Power, the BEWAG Group is the largest producer of renewable energy in Austria, and the Group operates in various Eastern European countries.

"I am happy that, after a period of developing projects in Eastern Europe, we are now coming to the point of realising wind power plants in the area. The new markets, yet to be developed, show great potential, and the know-how acquired in Burgenland/Austria can also be put into good use. With Vestas we feel that we have a strong partner for our project in Horni Lodenice," says Hans Lukits, Chief Executive Officer of BEWAG.
