Vestas receives order for 16 V90-2.0 MW turbines in Bulgaria

Vestas Central Europe has received an order for delivery of 16 V90-2.0 MW wind turbines for the region of Kavarna, Bulgaria. The order has been received from the company Raiffeisen Energy & Environment GmbH (REE). Delivery of the turbines will take place during the fourth quarter of 2008, and commissioning of the turbines is planned for the end of 2008.

"We are very satisfied with this new project, which shows the positive development of the wind energy market in the Eastern European countries.
