Vestas receives order for V90-3.0 MW turbines for the Turkish market

Vestas has received an order for 15 units of the V90-3.0 MW wind turbine for the Bandırma project located in the Balıkesir Province, south of Marmara Sea, Turkey. The contract includes supply and installation of the turbines, the VestasOnline™ Business SCADA solution as well as a five-year service agreement.

The order has been placed by Borasco Enerji ve Kimya A.Ş., a member of the MET Group of Companies chaired by Dr.Celal Metin.

The perspectives for the development of wind power in Turkey are very positive. During 2007, Vestas delivered wind turbines with a total capacity of 41 MW to Turkey, and it is expected that a total of 200 MW of wind power will be installed in Turkey during 2008.¹

“We are very pleased that Borasco has chosen Vestas turbines for their first wind power plant and we look forward to our future cooperation. With the establishment of Vestas Türkiye in January 2008, Vestas is looking forward to playing an important role in the growth of the promising wind energy market in Turkey. Support from the Turkish government to promote wind energy as a growing part of the Turkish energy mix will help to position Vestas as No. 1 in Modern Energy,” says Mr. Murat Onuk, General Manager of Vestas Türkiye.

With an estimated annual production of approx 180 GWh, the Bandırma wind power plant will save the environment from more than 82,000 tons of CO₂ emissions and will be able to meet the electricity needs of more than 28,350 Turkish households.

Delivery is scheduled to start during the last quarter of 2008, and the project will be completed by the second quarter of 2009.
