Vestas receives order for 16 turbines for Poland

Vestas has received an order for 16 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine for the project Sniatowo, located in the north-western part of Poland. The contract consists of supply, installation and commissioning of the wind turbines, a VestasOnline® Business SCADA system as well as a five-year service agreement.

The order has been placed by the Vortex Energy Group, which is a German developer with close ties to local partners in Poland who are building a substantial pipeline of projects in Poland in the coming years.
