Vestas receives order for 18 turbines for Sweden

Vestas has received an order for 18 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine for the project Bliekevarv in the Northern part of Sweden. The contract consists of supply, installation and commissioning of the wind turbines, a Vestas Online Business™ Scada System, a condition monitoring system as well as a two-year service agreement.

The order was received from Vindkompaniet AB, a long time customer of Vestas and one of Scandinavia's largest developers.

"We are pleased to announce the signing of another project with Vindkompaniet, and we look forward to continuing our good cooperation with them on this new 36 MW Bliekevarv project," says Tord Östlund, Sales Director of Vestas Northern Europe AB, and he concludes: "With this project, Vestas Northern Europe has taken an important step in the direction of securing strategic and important projects in Sweden."

The turbines will be delivered in the autumn of 2008, and installation will take place at the end of 2008.
