### **Vestas and Bella Center secures clean energy for UN Climate Summit in Copenhagen (COP 15)**

Vestas and Bella Center have joined forces to give the summit a CO<sub>2</sub>-balanced profile and will install a wind turbine at Bella Center in Copenhagen in the spring of 2009. The turbine will be operating through December 2009 where Bella Center is hosting the UN Climate Conference.

*"The Bella Center has during the last year worked on a CO<sub>2</sub> strategy, and the goal is to bring down the consumption of CO<sub>2</sub> by 20 per cent from 2007 to 2009,"* says Technical Director Kristian Orting, Bella Center.

*"We would like to show that wind energy is a clean and competitive technology – it is modern energy. We are very pleased with the cooperation with Bella Center which gives us an opportunity to show the delegates at the climate summit the power of wind. We believe wind power can cover 10 per cent of the world's electricity supply by 2020, if the necessary investments are made now,"* says Klaus Steen Mortensen, President of Vestas Northern Europe A/S.

The wind turbine will have a total height of 75 m and the diameter of the blades will be 52 m. The turbine has an estimated yearly production of 1,600,000 kilo watt hours and it is owned by Vestas. The turbine will be located outside the main entrance of the Bella Center for about a year and will then be sold to a permanent project.
