Vestas receives 51 MW order in Poland

Vestas has received an order from Dong Energy for delivery of 17 units of the V90-3.0 MW wind turbine for the Karcino project in Poland. The project has a total capacity of 51 MW and will be installed on the northwest coast of Poland not far from Szczecin. The contract includes supply, installation and commissioning of the turbines, a VestasOnline[®] Business SCADA system and a five-year service agreement. Delivery of the turbines is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2009.

The Karcino project is the third contract which Dong Energy signs with Vestas in Poland. Previous orders have also been located on the northwest coast of Poland.

"It is with great pleasure that we announce the signing of the project, and we are happy with the continued commitment which Dong Energy has shown Vestas," says Klaus Steen Mortensen, President of Vestas Northern Europe. This contract enhances our sustained market leadership in Poland and will support our planned expansion on the Polish market."

"Vestas is an important partner in the ongoing work on increasing DONG Energy's proportion of electricity generated from renewable energy sources, and we are very pleased with the cooperation with Vestas in Poland," says Christina Grumstrup Sørensen, Vice President and head of Wind Development and Construction at DONG Energy.

The Karcino project will be one of the largest wind power plants in Poland to date. When put into production, the plant will save the environment from an annual emission of almost 105,000 tons of CO₂.
