Location of turbines for Swedish project determined

In 2008, Vestas received an order for 100 MW for Sweden from Vattenfall Vindkraft Sverige AB, cf. company announcement No. 41/2008 of 28 August 2008. It has now been decided that almost 80 MW of the total order will be located in Stor-Rotliden, in the Åsele region in the northern part of Sweden. The Stor-Rotliden project comprises 29 units of the V90-2.0 MW turbine and 11 units of the V90-1.8 MW turbine.

Delivery of the wind turbines is still scheduled to be completed in 2010.

“We are very happy to start the process of establishing one of Sweden’s largest onshore wind parks in collaboration with Vattenfall,” says Klaus Steen Mortensen, President of Vestas Northern Europe. He continues: *“Vestas has ambitious goals for the Swedish market, and especially the Stor-Rotliden project supports our position as No. 1 in Modern Energy in Sweden.”*

When put into production, the plant will save the environment from an annual emission of almost 14,000 tons of CO₂.
