Vestas receives 34 MW order in Sweden

Vestas has received an order from Eolus Vind AB for delivery of 17 units of the V90-2.0 MW wind turbine. The order has a total capacity of 34 MW distributed on several projects in the southern part of Sweden. Delivery of the turbines is scheduled to be completed in the middle of 2010.

The contract includes supply, installation and commissioning of the turbines, a VestasOnline[®] Business SCADA system and a three-year service agreement.

"It is with great pleasure we announce this order and we are pleased with the commitment and trust, which Eolus Vind once again has shown us. Eolus Vind is one of the key players in Sweden with significant plans for developing wind power in our country and we look forward to a continued cooperation in the years to come," says Krister Poole Jönsson, Sales Director, Vestas Northern Europe.

When put into production, the plants will save the environment from an annual emission of more than 30,000 tons of CO₂ compared with average EU electricity.
