Vestas receives 54 MW order in Mexico

Vestas has received a 54 MW order for 30 units of the V100-1.8 MW wind turbine in Mexico.

The contract comprises delivery, transportation, installation and commissioning of the turbines, a VestasOnline® Business SCADA system as well as a 15-year service and availability agreement.

Delivery of the turbines is scheduled for the second quarter of 2013 and the wind power plant is expected to be commercially operational during the first quarter of 2014.

At the customer's request, additional details about the project and customer cannot be disclosed at this time.

"We are pleased to supply 54 MW of new wind energy capacity to Mexico, thus supporting the country's commitment towards the reduction of carbon emissions and fossil fuel consumption. This project shows our engagement in the country, where we look forward to continuing playing an important role in the expansion of its energy mix," states Adrian Katzew Corenstein, General Manager, Vestas Mexico & Caribbean.
